

QUALIFICATIONS AS A VOTER

According to Section 88 of the Constitution of Swaziland–

- (1) Subject to the provisions of section 89, a person is qualified to be registered as a voter if, and not otherwise qualified unless, that person has attained the age of eighteen years and is a citizen or ordinary resident in Swaziland.
- (2) A person qualified for the purposes of this section is entitled to be registered as a voter in one Inkhundla only.
- (3) A person is ordinarily resident in Swaziland where that person has lived in, has been associated with, that Inkhundla for a period of not less than five years or is permanently resident in Swaziland and has relevant document to that effect.

DISQUALIFICATION AS A VOTER

According to Section 89 of the Constitution of Swaziland–

- (1) A person is not qualified to be registered as a voter or to vote where that person-
 - (a) Is certified to be insane or otherwise adjudged to be of unsound mind under the law for the time being in force in Swaziland
 - (b) Is, for an act which is a criminal offense under the law of Swaziland, under sentence of death or life imprisonment imposed on that person by a court in any country; or
 - (c) Is disqualified for registration as a voter under any law for the time being in force in Swaziland relating to offences connected with elections.
