

## REPORT OF THE EBC

### According to the Constitution Section 92 –

(1) The Commission shall as soon as practicable after every election produce and submit a report on that election to the minister responsible for the elections, stating-

- (a) The general conduct of the elections and the number of voters who participated;
- (b) Any irregularities or abnormalities observed;
- (c) Whether any nomination or the election was disputed and with what result;
- (d) Any observed or remarkable peculiarities;
- (e) Recommendations, if any.

(2) The report of the Commission in terms of section 91 shall state, among other things, whether-

- (a) Any alteration is necessary to the boundaries of any Inkhundla;
- (b) Any one additional Inkhundla or more should be established; or
- (c) Any Inkhundla should be abolished or merged with any other.

(3) The report of the Commission under section 91 shall also contain the proposed boundaries of the affected Inkhundla or Tinkhundla.

(4) The King shall as soon as practicable after the submission of the report of the Commission as and in any event not later than six months before the dissolution Parliament in terms of section 134 (2), by proclamation in the Gazette declare the boundaries of an Inkhundla or Tinkhundla as delimited by the Commission to be effective at the dissolution of Parliament or so soon thereafter as may be convenient for the next general elections.
